

FLORIDA NURSE EDUCATION & WORKFORCE DATA

Florida Nursing Education in 2014

- 11,270 students were enrolled in nursing programs in 24 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 5,106 students graduated from nursing programs in 24 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 4,176 qualified applications to nursing programs were turned away from 24 nursing schools that responded to the NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing, due primarily to the following *two* reasons:¹
 - ❖ faculty shortage
 - ❖ other resource constraints

Florida Nursing Workforce 2016

- 65,564 licensed PNs reside in Florida.²
- 291,144 registered nurses reside in Florida.²

In 2015, the Florida state received Title VIII Grant of \$6,424,009.³
