Indiana Nursing Education in 2014

- 9,513 students were enrolled in nursing programs in 16 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 4,003 students graduated from nursing programs in 16 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 3,986 qualified applications to nursing programs were turned away from 16 nursing schools that responded to the NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing, due primarily to the following *two* reasons:¹
 - ❖ faculty shortage
 - ❖ other resource constraints

Indiana Nursing Workforce in 2016

- 26,719 licensed PNs reside in Indiana.²
- 105,434 Registered Nurses are licensed in Indiana.²

In 2015, the Indiana state received Title VIII Grant of \$2,713,181.³
