

NEW JERSEY NURSE EDUCATION & WORKFORCE DATA

New Jersey Nursing Education in 2014

- 14,659 students were enrolled in nursing programs in 30 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 3,498 students graduated from nursing programs in 30 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 1,061 qualified applications to nursing programs were turned away from 30 nursing schools that responded to the NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing, due primarily to the following *two* reasons:¹
 - ❖ faculty shortage
 - ❖ other resource constraints

New Jersey Nursing Workforce in 2016

- 23,774 licensed PNs reside in New Jersey.²
- 122,076 registered nurses are licensed in New Jersey.²

In 2015, the New Jersey state received Title VIII Grant of \$2,777,673.³
