

PENNSYLVANIA NURSE WORKFORCE INFORMATION

Pennsylvania Nursing Education in 2014

- 21,332 students were enrolled in nursing programs in 29 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 7,371 students graduated from nursing programs in 29 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 3,022 qualified applications to nursing programs were turned away from 29 nursing schools that responded to the NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing, due primarily to the following *two* reasons:¹
 - ❖ faculty shortage
 - ❖ other resource constraints

Pennsylvania Nursing Workforce in 2016

- 58,194 licensed PNs reside in Pennsylvania.²
- 216,438 registered nurses are actively licensed in Pennsylvania.²

In 2015, the Pennsylvania state received Title VIII Grant of \$5,085,543.³
