

SOUTH DAKOTA NURSE EDUCATION & WORKFORCE DATA

South Dakota Nursing Education in 2014

- 848 students were enrolled in nursing programs in 2 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 426 students graduated from nursing programs in 2 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 23 qualified applications to nursing programs were turned away from 24 nursing schools that responded to the NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing, due primarily to the following *two* reasons:¹
 - ❖ faculty shortage
 - ❖ other resource constraints

South Dakota Nursing Workforce 2016

- 2,482 licensed PNs reside in South Dakota.²
- 16,982 registered nurses are actively licensed in South Dakota (2015).²

In 2015, the South Dakota state received Title VIII Grant of \$1,414,108.³
